Pleasure Tips



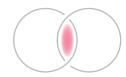
Apply the rounded nose on your clitoral glans and bring down the rest of the flame on the labia around.

Use The Firefighter during penetrative sex to add clitoral stimulation, which most vulva owners need to orgasm.

Vibrator Hygiene
